The institutional strategic or perspective planning process offers stakeholders, such as teachers, students, management, alumni, and other staff members, the opportunity to make informed

The current long-term perspective plan spans from 2022-23 to 2025-26 and is prepared by the relevant departments and sectional heads. It encompasses both quality and quantity goals for the institute.

To ensure effective implementation, the five-year institutional perspective plan is divided into annual plans. Once the annual plan is finalized, appropriate measures and resources are dedicated to its achievement. At the end of each academic year, the implementation of the annual plan is assessed, and necessary steps are discussed and finalized to address any remaining objectives in the following academic year.

The Director and Heads of Department engage in discussions and reviews of the perspective plan and its annual components. If needed, adjustments are made to accommodate new circumstances. The College Development Committee and Board of Control are also kept informed of the progress of the perspective plan. This ensures the effective deployment of the institutional strategic/perspective plan.
