

#### Analysis:

- It is evident from the graph mentioned above that, majority of the students are satisfied with the curriculum, academic performance, and the assistance provided by the faculties.
- 2. The 81.42% (30+12+15=57) of students says syllabus is challenging regarding fulfilling the objectives of the programme.
- Near about 75.71% (30+10+13=53) students says that the syllabus is bridge the gap between academics and Industry.
